



# VILLAGE GOLF AND SPORTS CLUB

## RULES

All members must adhere to the following rules to maintain the condition of the course and to ensure safety. Members should ensure that guests also keep to these rules.

1. Membership discs must be displayed when on the course. (Membership discs are not transferrable.)
2. Non-members must be accompanied by a member and pay the appropriate Green Fee before play.
3. Playing Juniors under 14 are welcome if accompanied by an older member. Non-playing Juniors should not be on the course.
4. Entry to Network Rail property is strictly forbidden. No items should be deliberately deposited or thrown onto Network Rail track or property.
5. Dogs are not permitted anywhere on the golf course or sports field.
6. Driving practice is allowed only on the allocated area parallel to the 2nd hole.
7. Play is not allowed until it is safe to do so and the course ahead is clear.
8. Slow play is to be avoided. Call a following group through if you have lost more than one hole to the group ahead.
9. Members and their guests must comply with normal golfing etiquette, in particular:-
  - a. suitable footwear must be worn to eliminate damage to the greens;
  - b. pitch marks on the greens must be repaired;
  - c. tee mats must be used;
  - d. divots must be replaced and
  - e. bunkers must be raked after use.
10. The 'local rules', which are printed on the reverse of the scorecards, should be observed.
11. Golf is played at your own risk. Accident insurance is not provided.
12. Subscriptions for existing Members are due by the last day of March. After that date Membership will be considered to have lapsed.
13. Failure to comply with these rules could lead to a request to leave the course or to have Membership of the Club withdrawn.
